2021 Finger Lakes Home & Garden Show Terms & Conditions Agreement

I. Eligible Exhibits: The refusal of a non-member to participate in the Home & Garden Show when viewed to be in the best interest of the Southern Tier Home Builders & Remodelers Association and its members is at the sole discretion of the Board of Directors. The decision of the Board is final.

II. Hold Harmless: To the fullest extent permitted by law, Exhibitor shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Southern Tier Home Builders & Remodelers Association, against any and all losses, claims, actions, demands, damages, liabilities or expenses, including but not limited to attorney's fees and all other cost of defense, by reason of the liability imposed by law or otherwise upon the Southern Tier Home Builders & Remodelers Association for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including employees, or on account of damages to property, including loss of use thereof, arising directly or indirectly from the performance of work or from any of the acts or omissions on the part of its employees, agents, representatives, material, men, suppliers and/or subcontractors.

III. General Liability Insurance: Exhibitors are required to insure against fire, theft, liability, and all risk of loss, should do so at their own expense. Certificate of Liability Insurance **MUST** be in a minimum amount of \$1,000,000. A Certificate of Insurance **MUST** list Southern Tier Home Builders & Remodelers Association (STHBRA) as an additional insured with the dates of the show, April 16 through April 18, 2021 that include set-up and teardown dates.

IV. Cancellations: Exhibitor may withdraw upon written notice. However, deposits/payments are non-refundable.

V. Payments: All deposits are non-refundable. All monies must be paid in full before the show.

Limitations:

- All water displays need to be approved by STHBRA.
- No flammable liquids or material of any nature allowed.
- Signs and displays must be kept within the confines of each booth. The dimensions of booths will be within pipe and drape.
- There is no soliciting or placing literature outside your designated booth space, including signage on venue property.
- Exhibitors shall not assign, sublet, or apportion the whole or any part of its allotted space, nor display any goods or services other than those manufactured or sold by that exhibitor due to the required general liability insurance.
- Exhibitors with cash and carry products must adhere to NYS tax requirements and are the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- Throwing souvenirs loud shouting, obstructing aisles, or other exhibits, etc. will not be permitted.
- Any exhibitor using music must ensure that licensing fees have been paid to the appropriate agency, i.e., ASCAP or BMI. STHBRA is not responsible for any licensing fees for music played in exhibitor's booth. Sound volumes must be kept at an appropriate level as not to interfere with neighboring booths.
